- **0.** The score should be interpreted as though written in the tenor clef, but may be transposed to any octave.
- 1. To be performed either in a space with rich natural reverb, or otherwise with simulated reverb.
- **2.** To be played as slowly as possible with each bar lasting between 10 and 15 seconds.
- **3.** All notes within a bar should be played as smoothly and softly as possible.
- **4.** Each system should be repeated the number of times indicated. The coda may be repeated *ad lib*.
